NOTICE TO ALL STUDENTS

Monday, 29th March, 2021

SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF PHYSICAL LEARNING AND TEACHING AT THE UNIVERSITY

This is to inform ALL students that the Murang'a University of Technology Senate in its 11th special meeting held on Monday, 29th March, 2021 resolved to suspend all physical teaching, learning and meetings in all Schools and Directorates with immediate effect till further notice, except for the medical courses. This is in compliance with the Presidential Executive Order of Friday, 26th March, 2021, on COVID-19 pandemic, that states:

“With respect to Education in Kenya, there shall be the immediate suspension of all on-going physical learning in all our education institutions including universities and tertiary and vocations colleges, other than for candidates sitting for their examinations and those in medical training institutions, until otherwise notified”

Pursuant to the above Executive Order, we wish to advise ALL students as follows:

- i. Examinations for Y3S1, Y1S2, and Y1S2 (*group which reported in January, 2021*) shall start as scheduled on **Tuesday, 6th April, 2021 – Friday, 16th April, 2021.**
- ii. Examinations for Y2S1, Postgraduate, Diploma and Certificate students shall start as scheduled on **Monday, 19th April, 2021 – Friday, 30th April, 2021.**
- iii. Ongoing online classes for Y2S1, Postgraduate, Diploma and Certificate students shall continue uninterrupted.

- iv. Those students who are scheduled to sit for examinations as indicated in (i) and (ii) above are expected to vacate the university for their homes immediately they finish doing the exams.
- v. The Y4S1 online lectures started on **Monday, 29th March, 2021**. All 4th year students are expected to attend the online lectures from their homes.
- vi. The May – August, 2021 **online lectures** for Y3S1 (*SET and BTED*), Y3S2, Y2S2 and Y1S1 (*those who reported in January, 2021*) will commence on **Monday, 19th May, 2021**. These students will attend these lectures from their homes, unless otherwise directed.

Further, ALL students should at all times observe the Ministry of Health guidelines and directives on COVID-19 pandemic containment measures.

We wish to assure our students and stakeholders that the university shall continue to maintain quality standards in all our programmes.
