NOTICE TO ALL STUDENTS

SUBJECT: UPHOLDING NATIONAL COHESION AND THE STRICT PROHIBITION OF
ETHNICALLY EXCLUSIVE GROUPINGS WITHIN THE UNIVERSITY
COMMUNITY

The University Senate wishes to remind all students that Murang'a University of Technology is a vibrant and inclusive academic community, home to individuals from a wide spectrum of ethnic, cultural, and regional backgrounds. This rich diversity stands as one of the institution's most treasured assets that deepens the learning experience, stimulates innovation, and strengthens the fabric of national unity.

It has, however, come to the attention of the Senate that a concerning trend has emerged, wherein students are forming associations and informal groupings along tribal lines. While the University firmly upholds every student's right to freedom of association, the establishment of exclusionary tribal groupings is strongly discouraged. Such formations are antithetical to the University's foundational principles of inclusivity, solidarity, and harmonious coexistence, and pose a direct threat to the cohesive and respectful environment that this institution strives to cultivate

In light of the foregoing, all students are hereby directed to observe the following:

- i. Refrain from forming, joining, or in any way participating in tribal-based or ethnically exclusive groupings.
- ii. Embrace the University's diversity wholeheartedly and actively cultivate meaningful relationships with fellow students from all backgrounds.
- iii. Engage with recognized, inclusive student organizations and partake in activities that promote unity and a shared sense of community.
- iv. Uphold, at all times, the values of mutual respect, tolerance, solidarity, and national cohesion, both within and beyond the University premises.

- v. Promptly report any conduct, activities, or undertakings that may incite division, perpetuate discrimination, or engender hostility within the University community.

The University Senate serves notice that firm and proportionate disciplinary action shall be instituted, in strict accordance with the University's statutes, rules, and regulations, against any individual or group found to be engaging in, or facilitating, practices that undermine the harmony, cohesion, and well-being of the institution.

All students are, therefore, earnestly encouraged to champion the ideals of unity, equity, and mutual respect, and to play an active and constructive role in nurturing a cohesive, inclusive, and thriving University community.
